III. Proof of Notice of Annual Meeting was presented by Richard Vickers.
IV. Reading \& Approval of the 2022 Annual Meeting Notes
a. Motion to dispense notes in lieu of reading was approved.
V. Reading and Approval of the Financial Report
a. Richard Vickers summarized the Financial Report.
b. Financial report is posted on the website http://my-elshaddai.com/ and the El Shaddai Facebook page. Hard copies were provided at the meeting.
c. Balance sheets shows a balance of $\$ 111,000.00$ in reserve - pretty much broke even this year
d. $\sim \$ 26,000$ in accounts receivable (owed but not paid)
i. Discussion: Richard discussed that we have limited options for enforcement
e. Income is lower this year
f. Admin expenses have dropped some
g. Road expenses: $\$ 8700$ this year (down from $\$ 15 \mathrm{~K}$ last year)
h. Water: \$13.5 last year, \$15K this year
VI. President's Report
a. Richard Vickers summarized the president's report
i. Many fine people who do a lot around here. Brian Patz - weedeats, Jerry Freudenthal - decorations, Mike Letscher - water
ii. Appreciates the sense of community here
VII. Old Business
a. Road Report
i. Tom McLean summarized the road report

1. Been too dry to grade
2. Will have an agreement for regular maintenance with Scotty Cope
3. Need a lot of gravel on back road (Lake Ridge)
b. Water Report
i. Christmas event
4. Faulty GFI caused pump issue, broken pipe
ii. Memorial Day event
iii. Recent event (9/12/23)
5. 4400 gallons
6. Holly found leak next to her house, Mike shut off valve, but didn't shut off completely
7. Sediment in the tank means we have to flush lines after outage
VIII. New Business
a. Proposal of new well to address water issues.
i. During some times of year, water usage outpaces supply
ii. Jennifer asked if a second tank would be helpful, Jerry said this was discussed years ago but it wasn't needed at the time. It would take up someone's property.
iii. Last special assessment for water system was in 1997
iv. Will probably need a $2^{\text {nd }}$ tank and a $2^{\text {nd }}$ well.
v. New tank, building, road would probably cost $\sim \$ 70,000-\sim \$ 100,000$
vi. New well $\sim \$ 40,000$ - risk of not finding water - budgeted for 600 ft
8. Would allow faster recovery
vii. There is a problem with the sensor to shut off the well when the tank is full
viii. Tom motions to drill a well.
9. Mo spent 25 years in fire service - supports water solutions for fire protections
10. Cookie - old tank was for filling firetrucks
11. Jerry - there are 2 tanks in the meadow
12. Mike - is afraid to touch anything because things break every time
13. Cliff - suggests wifi enabled gate valves
a. Tom says that Verizon may come here soon
b. Sensor currently runs of Richard's satellite
14. Brian McLoone - what is the cost?
a. Proposes adding annual cost to help with sensors
15. Cookie would like a breakdown of costs - actual breakdown
a. Richard estimates $\$ 40,000$ total
