- 1.A list of the names of the property owners and the number of lots the are paying for to tap into the system.
- 2. Payment of the \$775. per lot will assure each lot owner of permanent hook up to the system.
- 3 It is under stood that all 61 members are assessed for the capital of \$775. per lot.
- 4. Members that paid for the installation of the permanent pipe in October 1986, that amount will be deducted from the initial cost of \$775., and they will pay the balance due.
- 5. Payment for the water system as follows: \$400. due 6/15/87 \$375. due 9/1/87
- 6. All 61 members will contribute any additional capital needed in the future for this system.
- 7.All 61 lots that are now sold will be (participate) in the system.

Motion seconded by Roger Mays Motion's passed.

Leo Gendreau made the motion that an expense fund be established as follows: \$6.00 per lot per year payable 4/20/87, then annually 1/1/88., A maintenance fund of \$60.00 per lot per year effective 1/1/88.

Motion seconded by Ed Smith, Motion passed.

Motions made by Leo Gendreau on tree maintenance as follows:

- 1. Before any trees are cut on any lot owner's property,
 the lot owner intending to cut the trees on the second
 party's lot or lot's must notify the owner or owner's
 in writing' by certified mail of the intent to selectively
 cut trees. The lot owner (s) of the property or properties
 whose trees are to be cut has 120 days to respond after written
 notice is given.
- 2. Lot owner's are to meet on said property for the purpose of marking tree's with ribbon
- 3. All cut trees and debris must be cleaned up and removed from said 10 Motion $\sec \mathbf{e}$ nded by Roger Mays.

Motion passed.
